

Site Rules & Other Information

Dear guests!

Welcome to our campsite "Berliner Camping Club"! We will do our best to make your holiday as pleasant as possible. To ensure that your neighbours also have a pleasant stay we ask you to pay attention to the following rules.

1. Arrival and Departure, Visitors

Please register at the reception on arrival. You need to show your identity card or passport. Day visitors must also register at the reception desk. Prices are stated in the price list.

Please make yourself familiar with the safety equipment, e.g. location of the fire extinguishers, soon after your arrival.

Do not dig any trenches or holes around your tent. Please ensure that nobody is harmed by tent pegs, ropes or other tent equipment.

On the day of departure, the pitch has to be cleared, cleaned and tidied before 11.00 a.m. Otherwise we will have to charge for a further night. Please settle accounts on the day before your departure.

2. Quiet Times, Reception Opening Hours

Quiet times are from: 1.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.

10.00 p.m. to 7.00 a.m. weekdays

11.00 p.m. to 7.00 a.m. Fridays and Saturdays

The reception is closed during these times!

3. Campsite warden

Follow the campsite warden's instructions. The campsite warden (or other authorized personnel) is allowed to expel guests from the camping site when they break the rules.

4. Water

As our campsite is located in a drinking water protection zone it is forbidden to spill any wastewater on and outside of the site or to wash cars or caravans. Please empty your wastewater and chemical toilets into the intended waste disposal points. Use the sinks for washing up. For hygienic reasons clothes must not be washed in the dish washing facilities. Drinking water can be taken from correspondingly labelled taps only. Please help to save drinking water.

5. Sanitary Facilities

You need special coins to take a shower. Coins can be bought at the reception; any unused coins can be changed into euros again.

Children under 6 years have to be accompanied by an adult or another responsible person to the sanitary facilities. Smoking is prohibited in the sanitary facilities.

6. Waste

Our waste containers are next to the main entrance. We separate waste. The yellow bin is for plastics and packaging waste, the blue bin is for cardboard and paper and the black ones are for residual waste. There are bins for glass waste, too. Don't dispose of bulky waste. Please respect the quiet times.

7. Barbecues

Campfires on the site and its closer environment (e.g. beach) are forbidden. Please use gas-fuelled or charcoal grills. Sometimes there is high risk of forest fire. Take note of the related notice at the reception or information board.

8. Dogs

Dogs (and other pets) have to be registered as well. We don't allow dog breeds which are registered as dangerous on our site. Please keep your dog on a leash at all times and dispose of your dog's faeces. The Berlin Dogs' bye-law bans dogs from the beach.

9. Trading on the campsite is not permitted!
